Canvassing the country- The end of last month and beginning of this one Bro. Nick, his boys, and I partnered up to sow the Word of God in a city just north of the capitol, Sofia. We also canvassed the surrounding villages nearby. God blessed us with good weather and strength to pass out 12,400 portions of the Word. This past Friday Alyssa, Chris, and I met up with them again to canvass 8 more villages north of us. It's a long term goal to canvass the entire country but little by little we are getting to it. Around 687 villages and 92 cities so far. We don't have much time to reach people. Recently Kensey, our oldest daughter, told me she read that Bulgaria has the fastest shrinking population in Eastern Europe. Nevertheless we rejoice in what God is doing here.

Karnobat- Services have been going well with an increase in attendance. Most Sunday mornings now the place is full and on Thursday evenings there have been more people also. This Sunday 2/10 we had a baby dedication service. The family of the child dedicated have been through some difficulties recently that have in the process made their faith stronger. Dobri is not getting any better. This man gave his life to Christ last summer and his family attests to the change in him; but he will see his Lord and Saviour soon unless the Lord intervenes. Josh, Acen, (young man from our church) and I went to visit and have prayer with him today. He is very weak now. His wife is to the point that she would rather let him go than see him suffer any longer. She, Tinka, and their daughter, Paula, have been faithful to church. Their son, Ruse, hasn't come to services yet; but I have talked to him at their place. Please pray for them.

Bulgaravo- Please pray for Ivanka. She recently read some gospel material that has her considering the seriousness of her soul. I told her that it is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God, especially if you don't know Him.
